## If a Dog Comes Near

Sing to the tune of, "Do Your Ears Hang Low?"

If a dog comes near, (step forward)

You must never, never fear (shake your finger)

Never run, never flee *(running motions)* 

Just be still as a tree (arms at sides or crossed over chest)

Never scream, never shout (hands cupped over mouth)

Just be quiet as a mouse (finger over mouth: "shh")

And the Dog won't bite. (zip the lips)

He may bark, he may growl (frown, grit teeth)

He may sniff you all around (move head around, sniffing with nose)

But I say that's OK ("OK" sign with fingers)

He will finally go away (turn shoulders)

If you're calm and you're quiet (arms at sides, finger on mouth: "shh")

Then you're doing it just right (thumbs up)

And the dog won't bite! (zip the lips)
