**SUMMARY:** Assist in the day to day operations in the Fund Development and Marketing Departments of PAWS Humane.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Serve as primary contact for all donors, assisting them with any questions or needs
- Receive and process all donations
- Maintain accurate and complete donor records in Donor Perfect, providing reports upon request
- Create, maintain, and distribute personalized thank you letters
- Manage and send end of year donation tax letters to big donors
- Work with Marketing Director to write and plan appeal letters
- Coordinate purchase and installation of memorials done through tributes
- Participate in rebranding of organization
- Organize, schedule, and plan all staff, board, and executive committee meetings, produce meeting notes
- Serve as point of contact for Community Room rental
- Explores opportunities for corporate relationships, sponsorships
- Create and run special donor programs (holiday cards, quarterly newsletters, etc.)
- Organize, run and attend 3rd party events, including volunteer supervision
- Assist in searching for new opportunities for fund development, large donor partnerships and projects
- Support the Fund Development committee: attend meetings, produce meeting notes, assist in follow-through.
- Create and manage Events calendar
- Prepare daily sales packets for entry in to accounting software
- Other duties as assigned.
